TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1. The competition will be played over 18 holes of medal play, in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Club. The decision of the Competition Committee will be final.
- 2. The competition is open to male and female amateur golfers who are members of an EGU affiliated golf club. Open to boys with a handicap not exceeding 12 and girls with a handicap not exceeding 18 under the current CONGU scratch score and handicapping scheme. The competition will be a qualifying competition for handicapping purposes.
- 3. Competitors must be aged under 18 at 00:00 hrs on 1st January 2015.
- 4. Entries will be limited to 80. In the event of this limit being exceeded there will be a ballot for places with a reserve list provided. The Competition Committee reserve the right to refuse entry without reason. **ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN MONDAY 13th JULY** on the completed form above, with a cheque for the entry fee of £40.00 made payable to **BROCKET HALL INTERNATIONAL LTD**. Refunds will not be given for withdrawals after the draw has been made.
- 5. In the event of a tie for the trophy the winner will be decided by the standard count-back method.
- 6. Practice rounds are permitted weekdays after 14:00 at £30 each and should be booked through Golf Reservations on 01707 394994. All guests must sign in on arrival.
- 7. The entry fee of £40 includes 18 holes on the Palmerston course with a buffet lunch on return to the Clubhouse. Prize giving will be at approximately 19:30.
- 8. Competitors are required to report to the relevant starting tees at least 10 minutes prior to their starting time, details of which will be posted to the address on the entry form as soon as possible after the closing date of Monday 13th July. Tee times will be between 12:00 and 14:00. The Competition Committee reserves the right to amend any starting times accordingly.
- 9. Competitors are informed that smart casual dress is in order all day and the use of mobile phones are restricted to be used in The Oak Room and surrounding patio areas and are strictly forbidden elsewhere within the Clubhouse and on the course.
- 10. Finally, in the interest of all parties, all competitors are expected to complete the full 18 holes, expect in exceptional circumstances where this is not possible. The estimated time for the round is 4 hours 10 minutes.
